With Governor Cooper's announcement that North Carolina will be moving into a "restricted" PHASE 2 on Friday May 22, I am forced once again to tell you that IMDC is still not able to open & welcome back our dancers! I know this is devastating news for most of us since we were counting on phase 2 to allow us the ability to offer private lessons prior to summer dance happenings at a larger capacity. The state mandate tells us that North Carolina will remain in this phase for 5 weeks. Based on these guidelines, we do anticipate being able to open for summer dance as planned on July 6.

We will continue an entire ZOOM series in the month of June: JUMP INTO JUNE from June 1<sup>st</sup> thru June 25<sup>th</sup>. Both of these services remain free to IMDC dancers.
